PROSPECTUS AND APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

The British Organ Grinders' Association was formed in 1992 by a group of hand-turned organ enthusiasts to represent the interests of organ grinders and to provide a forum for the exchange of information and ideas specifically of interest to them.

The objectives of the Association include the following:

- To promote and publicise members' activities
- To publish a newsletter reporting subjects of interest to organ grinders
- To provide an information service for Members
- To encourage social and other gatherings of Members
- To promote an interest in street organs and mechanical music

Members receive:

- A quarterly newsletter, for the whole year of membership

- Official membership/ID Card
- Personalised button lapel badge(s)

The British Organ Grinders Association is non-profit making and all members involved in the administration give their time without charge. All expenses necessarily incurred are accounted for and subject to an annual external examination.

Membership is open to anyone owning, or simply having an interest in, hand-turned organs and can include partners or other members of one family at no extra cost. Membership runs from 1st January to 31st December each year and the Annual Subscription in the UK is £15, or 35 Euros for European friends. Subscription rates for non European membership are available on application. Membership renewals are issued with the Christmas edition of "Organ Grinders' News".
